Remembering Dr. Rod Capistran: A Scholarship to Honor a Respected Mathematics Teacher

Rod Capistran was a beloved math teacher at Fargo North High School from 2003 until his unfortunate passing in 2020. His students created this scholarship in memory of him to pay tribute to his inspiring legacy. Not only did he hold a degree in Mathematics, but he was also a talented musician who played the trombone and sang.

Capistran earned a Bachelor's Degree from Bemidji State University in both Mathematics and Music Education. He further pursued his studies in Mathematics, completing a Master's Degree from the University of Iowa and a PhD in Mathematics Education from the University of Minnesota. Dr. Capistran was passionate about teaching all areas of math, and he taught various sections of Geometry and Algebra during his tenure at Fargo North High School.
