Lenore and Norman Tenneson were ardent supporters of education and community service. Lenore was a teacher at a one-room schoolhouse in western North Dakota and Agassiz Junior High School in Fargo. She dedicated her time to volunteering in her church, the YWCA, the AAUW, and the local Democratic Party. Lenore's noteworthy achievements include her appointment by President Lyndon Johnson to the National Citizen's Committee on Community Relations in 1964. Norman practiced law for over 50 years and was a senior partner at Tenneson, Serkland & Lundberg et al. He held multiple leadership positions throughout his career, including as President of the North Dakota Bar Association, St. Luke's Hospital, and First Methodist Church.

Lenore and Norman placed great value on education and community service. They believed that education was the foundation for a fulfilling and well-rounded life. In turn, they felt a strong sense of responsibility to give back to their community by dedicating their time, energy, and talents to worthwhile causes.

The Lenore and Norman Tenneson Scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating senior from Fargo South High School. The recipient of the scholarship is a student who has demonstrated a strong desire to learn and understands the value of education, reflecting the same values that Lenore and Norman upheld throughout their lives.
