In honor of Coach Ray Callaghan, Fargo North Class of 1991 Boys Basketball players Michael Solberg, Steven Ratti, John Messelt, Rick Sanstad, Laine Brantner, and Michael Cowman established this scholarship. The annual award is given to a Fargo North High School senior who has participated in at least two years of Fargo North Boys or Girls Basketball and/or Golf, and is interested in pursuing a degree in a mathematics field.

Coach Callaghan was a retired faculty member of Fargo North, where he taught math and coached sports for 31 years. During his head coaching tenure, the golf team achieved two state titles, and he was selected as State Coach of the Year multiple times, and even nominated as National Golf Coach of the Year. In basketball, he led the team to a State Championship in 1985 and was awarded State Coach of the Year.
