2. Outline your academic performance and significant accomplishments, including your G.P.A.
3. How have you demonstrated compassion toward people who are not as fortunate as you?
4. Indicate how you have exhibited kindness and respect in your dealings with your classmates, teachers, coaches and parents.
5. Discuss your college plans, including where you plan to attend, your field(s) of interest, and how receipt of this scholarship would assist your plans.
