This scholarship was established in memory of Edward E. Simonson to commemorate his vision, patronage, stewardship, and contributions to the commonweal of the Fargo community. Edward was born in Finley, ND, as a first generation American to Norwegian immigrants. After completing an 8th grade education and serving in World War I, he moved to Fargo and worked his way through the Fargo Business College. Following graduation, he worked at several local businesses and eventually became CEO of a regional manufacturing business.

Over the course of decades, he successfully grew the business, employed hundreds of individuals, and left a generational legacy for dozens of families. Additionally, over the course of his lifetime, he served in various capacities on many State and local businesses and civic organizations, which included: Director of the Board First International Bank and Trust, Member of the ND House of Representatives, President of the Greater North Dakota Association, member of the Fargo Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of the North Dakota Cancer Fund Campaign.

This scholarship is to be awarded annually using the below criteria. Applications will be **reviewed by the FARGO SOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REVIEW COMMITTEE AND/OR ACADEMIC GUIDANCE COUNSELORS** with knowledge of the student's performance, extra-curricular activities, and personal merit.

General Scholarship Requirements

- Graduating senior from South High School;
- Priority is to be given to applicants who are first-generation U.S. citizens;
- Has maintained a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better;
- Applicant must demonstrate and interest in an entrepreneurial, business, or public service field;
- Intends to pursue a business-related or public service education program at a 4-year post-secondary institution;
- Barring any unforeseen circumstances the applicant/recipient must be present at the scholarship award ceremony.
