Jay went on to pursue higher education at the University of North Dakota, where he earned his undergraduate and master's degrees in education and vocational education.

Jay's career began as a DECA teacher in Grafton, North Dakota. He was known for his immense passion for teaching and dedication to the communities he served. Even after his high school teaching days ended, Jay continued to coach and judge high school speech students.
