Helen Ericson Fossum graduated from Fargo Central High School in 1932 and was an active participant in various organizations such as the National Honor Society, Quill and Scroll, Sportsmanship Club, and the Interscholastic Debate Club. Her passion for literature and arts never waned.

She continued to live in Fargo throughout her adult life, where she made significant contributions to the community. Helen served on the Fargo School Board, co-founded the Fargo Opportunity School, and was a distinguished member and president of the Fine Arts Club of Fargo. She delighted in speaking engagements and creating thoughtful book reviews. This scholarship was created to honor her unwavering commitment to learning.
