1. Outline your involvement in activities/athletics over the past four years and include any special honors or recognition you received.
2. Outline your academic performance and significant accomplishments, including your G.P.A.
3. How have you demonstrated compassion toward people who are not as fortunate as you?
4. Indicate how you have exhibited kindness and respect in your dealings with your classmates, teachers, coaches, and parents.
5. Discuss your post-secondary plans, including where you plan to attend, your field(s) of interest, and how receipt of this scholarship would assist your plans.

The applicant may be contacted for a personal interview to supplement the written information provided.
